## BANK MUAMALAT TANAH MERAH CONFIRMS EMPLOYEE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

**Kuala Lumpur, 10 November 2020** - Bank Muamalat Malaysia Berhad (Bank Muamalat) has confirmed that one of its employees at the Tanah Merah branch has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus and is now under the care of a government hospital.

To mitigate possible health risks due to the rising number of COVID-19 cases, the Tanah Merah branch is closed from 8 November, 2020 until further notice.
